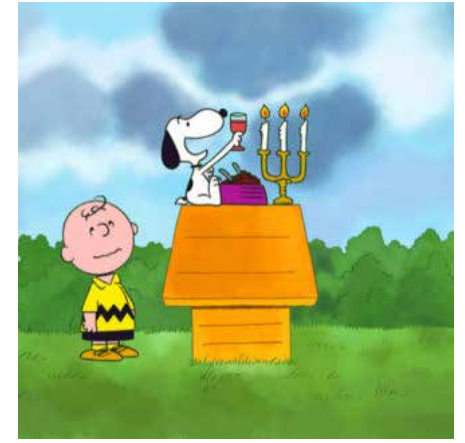
Come view these spectacular animals of the spirit on First Friday and enjoy the beats of DJ Selecta Shaggy.
